INC is an international arbitration and negotiation competition organized by Sophia University in Tokyo. Leading law students from top universities in various countries such as Australia, Netherlands, and Singapore, are invited to the competition and are judged by Japanese and International Bar association members and professors from top law universities of Japan. The competition has two sections, namely arbitration, and negotiation. The workload is quite intense; participants must form teams with 5 members and have a professor-coach. Our university's coach is Professor Sean McGinty of Law faculty and every participant is required to take his course 'Advanced Lecture (Intercollegiate Negotiation Competition)'
